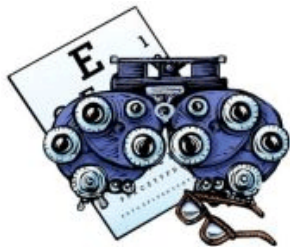

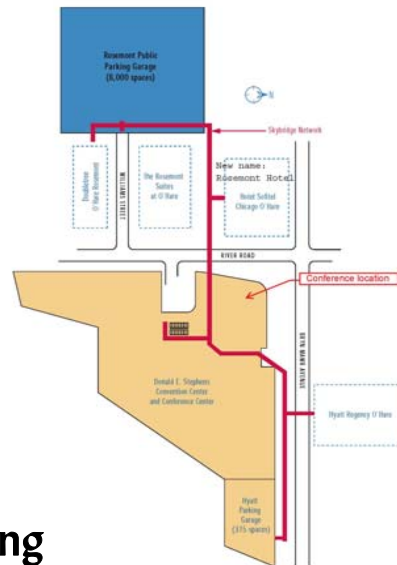


Registration
